- b. \_\_\_\_\_ ruled for 40 years at a time that was known as the 'Golden Age' of Poland and the Great Duchy of Lithuania.
- c. \_\_\_\_\_ will be remembered for his victory over the Teutonic Order and the Peace Treaty in Toruń in 1466.
- d. \_\_\_\_\_ was defeated in 1497 during his expedition to conquer Moldavia.
- e. \_\_\_\_\_ led to victory Polish and Lithuanian forces together with Witold, the Grand Duke of Lithuania in the Battle of Grunwald in 1410.
- f. \_\_\_\_ died in the Battle of Varna at the age of 20.
- g. \_\_\_\_\_ being the last descendant of the Jagiellonian family, in 1575 she was given the title of a king.
- h. \_\_\_\_\_ was paid homage to by Albert Hohenzollern, the Duke of Prussia in 1525 in Kraków.
- i. \_\_\_\_\_ reigned for 48 years the longest time in Polish history!
- j. \_\_\_\_\_ signed in 1505 the Act of Nihil Novi, which restricted the powers of the king.
